Introducing World Fantasy Convention 2025 Guest of Honour - Suniti Namjoshi


Our Author Guest of Honour is Suniti Namjoshi.







Introducing World Fantasy Convention 2025 Master of Ceremonies - Sarah Pinborough

Event Timings & Programme

The main activities of the event will start after lunch on the Thursday and end after the World Fantasy Awards on Sunday afternoon. However we may have some pre-convention workshops on Thursday Morning.

Details of Art Show and Dealer set up times will be emailed to Dealers and Artists closer to the time.

On each day there will be a reception or larger event; on Thursday the Opening Ceremony & Welcome reception; Friday the Mass Autographing, Saturday the Art Reception and, in the evening the British Fantasy Awards; on the Sunday the Banquet and World Fantasy Awards.

We will also have online content and plan to start this in the Spring to whet the appetite for the event itself. Selected event activities will be streamed live and available for catch up after the event.

The full programme is intended to be released about a month before the event.
